His work investigates specific effects of a geographic environment on the emotions of an individual thru the intersection of photography, videography and conceptual installation. Cory obtained an AAS in Architectural Drafting from Lane Community College in 2001 and a BFA in Multimedia from the School of Architecture and Allied Arts at the University of Oregon in 2004.

Relying on education and trusting an intuitive design practice attained from his roots, Cory now co-owns a graphic design and web design studio in Cannon Beach, Oregon. Crowerks is a design studio collective that specializes in the design and implementation of creative advertising for hospitality, restaurateurs, Pacific NW travel productions, and surf culture / surf retailers. Primarily focused on identity design, web design and apparel design they strive to tell clients' stories through the tools they develop. Simply put; Crowerks dreams and conceives powerful visuals for clientele stories.

Recent exhibitions and screenings include venues such as Cannon Beach Gallery (Cannon Beach, OR), Coaster Theatre (Cannon Beach, OR), Kco Gallery (Cannon Beach, OR), (S)PACE (Seattle, WA) and 1875 Belmont Warehouse (Portland, OR). In 2007 he received an Individual Artist Grant from the Cannon Beach Arts Association for a solo exhibit.
